

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you with details of the booking system for our critical workers and vulnerable children provision. I apologise if this differs from any communication given earlier this week. I hope you will fully understand that this is an ever-changing situation and we are responding to demand and need as it arises.

Moving forward, each week, we will open a new booking system and you will be provided with a copy of the link. **Please note that this will be a new web link each week.** The booking form will go live every Thursday morning and will take bookings until 6pm on Friday in readiness for the following week. This allows us to plan our staffing capacity and confirm bookings. Places are limited - please only book provision if you have exhausted all other childcare solutions.

It is very important that you **only book the days that you intend to use.** The Government has given us clear guidance on the recording of attendance. If you have booked a place and your child does not attend then **this will be recorded as an authorised absence** which will appear on their school attendance record and Praising Stars reports. The children who are not in school, but who did not book a place, are marked with a different code which does not affect their attendance record.

It is also important to only book the places that you need as we have seen significant demand for places in the provision. In some cases, we are running normal class sized groups. As you will be aware, we are also live teaching all of our children remotely and therefore our staffing capacity for onsite provision is limited. As a result, **if demand exceeds our capacity we will have to begin limiting places and prioritising provision.**

Children working onsite are accessing the same provision as those working online at home. In some cases across the Trust, the onsite provision is being supervised by our fantastic support staff. Due to high demand for places within our academy, this may be something we need to introduce. I am sure that you will join me in congratulating all staff, who are working hard both in school and online, for the way that they have responded to this incredible challenge in such a short space of time. It has been just lovely to receive and read the comments from many of you, particularly on how the live teaching is providing higher levels of both structure and engagement and how as an academy we have responded to this situation. Now, more than ever, the support from and for the Lofthouse Family is greatly welcomed and as said before, we are all in this together.

Equally, to help us with planning the availability of places, it is important that if you no longer need the place that you have booked then you **cancel it in advance as soon as you know it is not required.** This means that we can make it available to another critical worker who may desperately need the provision in order to support the country's fight against the spread of the virus.

Please be aware that we may need to close to groups of children should there be a reported positive COVID case within a bubble. It is therefore important that as critical workers, you plan alternative emergency arrangements in the eventuality of us having to inform you of the need for your child to isolate. This is beyond our control and we are not able to offer alternative arrangements as isolation of close contacts is a key way of controlling the spread of the virus and a legal requirement of the academy.

You should assume that **your booking is confirmed unless we contact you.** This will remain open until 6pm on Friday. Once the booking form has closed, we will be unable to accept additional children **unless this is done by contacting the academy office in advance by email or telephone.** In such cases, we will try to accommodate your needs but cannot guarantee provision.

Should you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact us. In the meantime, on behalf of the academy I would like to offer our thanks for your ongoing work as a critical worker - this is a difficult time for us all but together we will return to more normal times.
