Dear Parents/Carers

Year 2 Trip – The National Coal Mining Museum

Next half term, as part of our history curriculum, we will be going to visit The National Coal Mining Museum. Children will have the opportunity to find out about mining in the area of Wakefield and experience life as a miner by going underground.

The visit will take place on **Friday 2nd February 2024**. We ask for a contribution of **£14.21** towards the cost of the trip to be paid by no later than **Monday 22nd January 2024**. It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for this valuable trip to take place and it will be cancelled.

Your child will need to arrive at school at 8.30am, and our expected return time is approximately 3.00pm. Children will be collected as normal from their classroom doors at 3:15pm. Your child will need to wear their school uniform, wear suitable shoes such as trainers for walking and have a coat with them. We will be outside for most of the day so please send suitable clothing dependent on the weather.

Your child will be provided with a packed lunch from the school kitchen. Please ensure you fill out their sandwich preference below and also details of any allergies they have. We will also be taking fruit for the children to have as a snack. If your child has packed lunches you can send them with this as normal.

A school packed lunch will consist of:

- Choice of sandwich - ham, cheese or tuna
- Plain sponge bun
- Fruit or veg sticks
- Bottle of water

Your child will need to bring their water bottle to school as normal, please note – children should not be sent with fizzy drinks or drinks in glass bottles. Children should carry this in a bag that they will be able to carry around with them easily such as a backpack.
