Dear parents and carers,

As part of our Platinum Jubilee Celebrations, we are taking part in the Platinum Jubilee Royal Reading Challenge set by the National Literacy Trust.



Your child will have been given a reading log by their teacher. The aim of the Platinum Jubilee Royal Reading Challenge is to increase the amount of reading children are doing. Children will need to read for 10 minutes to earn themselves a milestone. Milestones will need to be signed and dated across the timeline by an adult (as shown below). There are 24 milestones in total. Children may have a maximum of 2 milestones signed and dated per day.

Children will need to complete the other parts of the reading log based on the first book that starts their reading journey off. Some children will read lots of books and others may only read one longer book.



Congratulations on completing the Platinum Jubilee Royal Reading Challenge by doing lots of brilliant reading!

Keep going on your reading journey as often as you can and see what else you can enjoy and discover.
