Assemblies

We have a composer of the week, which is shared as the children enter and leave the hall. We listen to different pieces of music and share key facts about the composer and the genre. Learner Model: A skill or quality from our Learner Model is introduced one week and the following week, a child from each class is celebrated for showcasing that quality or skill.



Star of the Week: Every Friday, we have our celebration assembly, 'Star of the Week'. Our Nursery and Reception children are also rewarded this in class. On a Friday, we also alternate between a Maths and English award, (YI-6) and Times Table Rockstar weekly certificates (Y2-Y6).

Curriculum: Throughout the year, we have showcase assemblies for different subjects. Our subject leads will host these and celebrate the learning journey from EYFS - Year 6. We will also reintroduce TTRS, My Maths and Accelerated Reader. We will have specific assemblies to share our OPA Diploma focus for each half term and opportunities for you to share your child's achievements from outside of school. Every term, we also host our Curriculum Talent Awards where children are nominated for their passion/enthusiasm/work in a specific subject and then our subject leaders choose one winner per subject.

Roles and Responsibilities: We have numerous assemblies planned in for our School Parliament, Mental Health and Wellbeing Champions, Reading Ambassadors and Digital Leaders to host. Coming up this half term will be launch assemblies and opportunities for children to apply for a role within the academy.

Key Events and Festivals:

Throughout the year, we celebrated key events, celebrations and festivals. We are keen to have visitors back in, including Reverend Coggins.

RSE: In line with our RSE curriculum, there will be numerous assemblies linked to relationships and health.
