### **4C Wakefield Museum Visit**

Dear parents/carers,

As part of their learning next half term, Year 4 have the exciting opportunity to visit Wakefield Museum.

The visit for **4C** will take place on **Thursday 13th June 2024**. We ask for a contribution of **£14.37** towards the cost of the trip to be paid by no later than **Friday 24th May 2024**. It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for this valuable trip to take place and it will be cancelled.

Your child will need to arrive at school at 8.45am, and our expected return time is approximately 3.00pm. Children will be collected as normal from their classroom doors at 3:15pm. Your child will need to wear their school uniform and school shoes and have a coat with them.

Your child will require a packed lunch for the trip. This packed lunch could be provided from home or alternatively a packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen. If you normally pay for school dinners a packed lunch from the school kitchen can be paid for on parentpay under school dinners as normal. If you are entitled to free school meals this packed lunch will be provided free of charge.

If you wish to have a packed lunch provided from school please ensure you fill out your child's sandwich preference below and also details of any allergies they have.

A school packed lunch will consist of:

- Choice of sandwich - ham, cheese or tuna
- Plain sponge bun
- Fruit or veg sticks
- Bottle of water

Your child will need to bring their water bottle to school as normal, please note – children should not be sent with fizzy drinks or drinks in glass bottles. Children should carry this in a bag that they will be able to carry around with them easily such as a backpack.
