Phonics Assessments



A big thank you for all the children and grown-ups that allowed us to assess our phonics groups online. This has allowed us to really keep a close eye on how the children are progressing, so that we can continue to personalise the phonics lessons to what they need. We are so proud of all the phonics lessons that are going on at home, and all the effort our children (and grown-ups!) are making to continue to do the daily tasks to develop and strengthen their phonics knowledge.

From WC 8th Feb your child may be placed into a new phonics group or, they may continue with their current learning. With this, your child may get a new Phonics teacher, or you may have a little bit of all of us! This is because we have now 4 different Phonics groups being taught daily and staff are working together to try and give the children the best phonics lessons they can. Any updates will be shared with you in the classroom.

Talk 4 Writing

We have had lots of lovely feedback about our Talk4Writing sessions on the book Monkey Puzzle. We are so happy that the children have enjoyed these lessons! Following what we normally do in school, we will now have a break from Monkey Puzzle and return to it at a later date. You may have some additional assignments set for opportunities for you to remember the story until that time.
