We have had a jam-packed half term this Spring 2 and how fantastic it has been, especially with our learning and progress! This term we have been very busy reading 'Superworm' and the children have been learning how to retell the story through Talk for Writing. Our topic this half term is called 'All Things Bright and Beautiful' and we have been learning all about the lifecycles of frogs and butterflies. We have even had some special visitors in our investigation area. We can't wait to watch them grow. We have also looked at the parts of a plant and our project work 'The Big Picture' has helped us produce some amazing nature landscape paintings.

Phonics

Our RWI phonics sessions are really helping the children to learn to read and write. The children have loved learning their new sounds and we will continue to blend and segment to develop our reading and writing. We will continue to send QR codes home weekly in their learning log so that the children can continue this learning at home.



Maths

In Maths, we have been learning about number bonds to 10 using ten frames and part-whole models. The children have also been learning about repeated patterns such as AB and ABC patterns. The children have enjoyed creating patterns in the provision!



'Read With Me' sessions

We would like the opportunity to thank all of the grown-ups who attended our 'Read With Me' sessions. These sessions are a great opportunity for you to not only share the love of reading with your child, but to also encourage language development and build their imagination. Starting from Thursday 20th April, our reading sessions will be every Thursday afternoon for **both** classes. These will start at 2:45pm and finish at 3:15pm.



After Easter, we will be beginning our PE lessons outside. We have been working so hard on our balancing skills, ball skills, jumping and landing and moving in different ways in our physical development area outside. During our PE sessions, we will be learning to get dressed and undressed, negotiating space and travelling rhythmically. Please provide your child with a PE kit which includes:

 - Black pumps

For our Literacy next half term, we will be reading and learning our Talk4Writing text 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. We will be looking at a range of fairy-tale stories. In our maths sessions, we will be focusing on doubling, halving and sharing, odd and even numbers and patterns. We have set time aside for interventions to take place to support any gaps in learning if necessary across the curriculum including social, communication and language, literacy, fine motor and maths, extra sessions for fine/gross motor skills, mental health and wellbeing sessions and more.
