Our Academy Parliament loves to run a competition! This month we are entering the 'Show Racism the Red Card' School Competition 2023.

The **Show Racism the Red Card (SRtRC) School Competition** is free to enter, open to **Year 1-6** and is a great follow-on activity to educational work about racism. We want to encourage children to think about racism and produce their own work about this serious issue. Your child is welcome to produce **artwork in the style of a t-shirt (front and back) or creative writing**. If it's about racism, we want to see it!

An independent panel of judges select the winning entries and winners are invited to a special Awards Ceremony at a Premier League stadium. Prizes are presented by special guests including current and former professional footballers. This is a unique opportunity for schools to proactively demonstrate their commitment to equality and tackling racism by taking part in the UK's largest equalities themed school competition.

As we are only able to enter **one entry, per category, per school**, our Academy Parliament will have the task of choosing which designs or pieces of writing will be sent off to the main judges. I predict this will be a very difficult task for them!

Your child will bring home a template of their choice (t-shirt or lined paper) and should return it completed to school no later than **Friday**, **24**^{*} **February**, **2023**.
