Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you are all having an enjoyable Summer and are ready and raring to return to the academy this Wednesday!

During the Summer holidays, we have been in contact with Normanton Leisure regarding the swimming lessons your child was unable to attend last academic year.

We are happy to confirm that they can offer your child (and the rest of Year 6) swimming lessons for the first term of 2021.

Sessions will be on a Monday morning and will start on Monday 13th September.

We are sending this email now to give you as much notice as possible.

A paper copy will be sent home on Wednesday 8th September as we do not expect you to print the slip out at home.

I'm sure you will join us in understanding that this new timetable allows all children the chance to attend statutory swimming lessons.

The term your child will attend lessons will allow them to work towards meeting the KS2 National Curriculum expectations of being able to swim 25m.

Children will be transported to and from the swimming pool by coach.

We appreciate it is short notice, but in order for us to plan swimming groups, we would be grateful if you could complete and return the slip to the office by **Thursday 9th**

September.

Important Information

The swimming pool is very strict on the following:

- Children will need to bring a towel
- Girls must wear a one piece swimming costume
- Boys must wear trunks (i.e. speedo type) not shorts or anything loose
- Absolutely no jewellery is allowed
- Long hair must be tied back
