This month in Reception!

We have had a wonderful month in Reception. We are so proud with how well the children have progressed in their phonics and number, the children are just brilliant! It has been so lovely to see all of your poppy creations, baking and odd socks! Thank you for the delicious treats you baked for us!

This month we have been so busy reading 'Cake' and looking at festivals and celebrations to help us write lists and labels.

Our RWI phonics sessions are really helping the children to learn to read and write. The children have loved learning their new sounds and we will continue to blend and segment to develop our reading and writing.

In Maths, we have been learning number bonds to 5 using parts and the whole.

In our Project work we have been exploring salt dough, play dough and clay. We will be creating our own Diva Lamps soon!

Next Month

Next month we will be reading one of our favourite stories 'Frozen', 'A Jolly Christmas Postman' and 'One Snowy Night'. We will be learning to retell the story, recognise familiar words and segment sounds in simple words.

We will continue with our phonics sessions where we will begin to segment and blend sounds to read words. Watch out for Fred the Frog who helps us sound out words! Remember to use those Fred Fingers too!

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn number bonds to 5 and introducing the part-whole model.



We are still continuing to practice our 'Nativity' so please keep learning those lines at home!

Our Christmas party will take place on **Thursday 16**th **December.** We will shortly be asking you to complete our party food list so we can begin our preparations for our festivities! **Thursday 16th December** is also our Christmas Jumper Day. Everybody is invited to wear their normal uniform with the addition of a festive jumper (or tshirt). Our Christmas dinner day will be on **Wednesday 15th December**.
